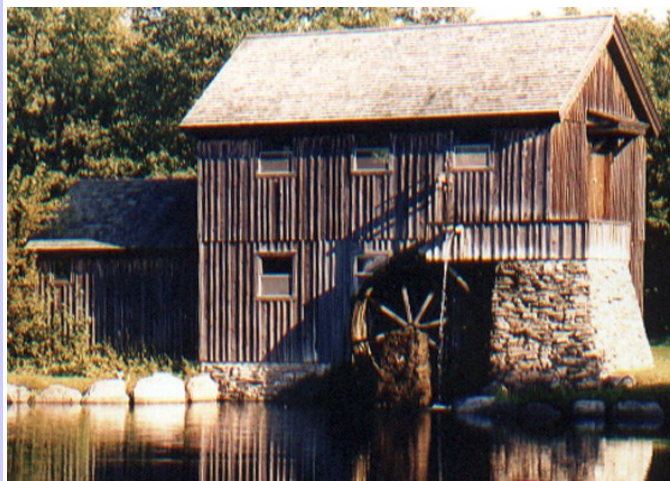

Paranormal Investigation of Midway Village

On Saturday May 10th, Midway Village in Rockford Illinois will be hosting a very special Public Event. Please join us, Paranormal Investigators of Milwaukee, along with Dale Kaczmarek, Ghost Research Society, and TNT Paranormal for this unique opportunity to investigate multiple buildings at this historic location. The Midway Village event is the perfect combination for those interested in the paranormal and history alike. This museum is set on a beautiful, 137-acre campus, with over 100,000 artifacts dating back to the 1830's. The Victorian Village displays 27 buildings demonstrating what a typical rural town life in northern Illinois at the end of the 19th century and early 20th century would have looked like.

The museum is also home to many exhibits including a sock monkey, Rockford's Pioneer aviators, founders of Rockford, and the "No Crying in Baseball" All-American Girls Professional Baseball League exhibit, which tells the story of the Rockford Peaches and their place in history. There is also a working replica of a water-powered machine house.



The purpose for organizing all of these buildings and exhibits was to preserve, collect and interpret the history of Rockford, IL. Now is your chance to find out what else is lurking in these buildings. This may be your opportunity to find out more about the "Ghosts of Rockford's past". We hope to see you on May 10th!
