Each month we'll highlight a member's story. This month we feature investigator **Chris Paul**

How long have you been a Paranormal investigator? It's hard for me to pin down when I first started investigating. It's been at least 25-30 years. My first exposure to actual "investigating" was back in the days of the Hans Holzer's books and W.S.P.R (which many members have already passed on). It seems in the early days I always "worked" with a psychic/medium, it was just the way it was done back then. Recording was done on cassettes and lots of flash photography since there was no such thing as night shot. Dowsing rods were also frequently used and a compass, which took the place of the modern day EMF meter. I guess I'm still old school on lots of things and trust my instincts more than anything else. I've often seemed to know where to point a camera at any given moment but I don't consider myself a sensitive.

How long have you been with PIM?

I've been involved with PIM for about 2 years now. Before that I was dormant for a little while since some of my former investigators had gotten just a little older and not investigating anymore. I also had one of my "teachers" pass on but I'll never forget the lessons she taught me, God Bless. I "shopped" around a bit and came across PIM. I really liked that they looked professional and credible.

What kind of equipment do you like to use on an investigation?

I guess you could call me old school but I prefer my camera and a recorder. The spirit will find me and often has.

Equipment Spotlight:



PIM Pod - This device detects positive and negative ions and turns on or off a light to indicate which is more abundant. In this device, a light comes on when positive ions are detected and the light goes off when negative ions are detected. This device can be used as an item in front of a stationary camera or used actively during an EVP session to try and get spirits to interact. This device is a cheap alternative to the pricey REM Pod sold by Gary Galka as they have similar features and do the same thing. This item was built by PIM member Randy.

Did you know that whenever PIM goes on an investigation they always write a report on their findings and experiences? Each report includes everything from the investigators present, the EMF and temperature readings from each room at the location, time and location of each EVP session and any experiences during them, Sensitive readings if there are any, equipment used and where it was placed and the outside conditions and environmental data. All of this takes a lot of time but is crucial to each investigation. The PIM website has an Environmental Data page that explains the importance of these readings. You can also find the reports themselves on our Cases page. Please take some time to check out these pages.
