PIM's Expedition to Pennsylvania

On May 30th PIM members Noah, Tony, John, Jann, and Missy loaded up our equipment and headed East for a 4 day trip to Pennsylvania. They teamed up with PIM-East members Michael and Josh to investigate Pennhurst State School and Hospital and Eastern State Penitentiary. After much research on these buildings, pouring over maps, and reading reports from teams that had gone in before them it was finally time for PIM to have their chance to investigate these historically haunted buildings. First stop Pennhurst. The grounds of Pennhurst were enormous and wild. Many of the buildings still lay as they did when the school closed in 1987. PIM would get the chance to focus on one building, the Mayflower Building. The Mayflower has 3 floors and a basement. It was over 90 degrees that weekend making running up and down the stairs during set up grueling but definitely worth it. The Mayflower housed a nurses ward on the 3rd floor, rooms for the residence on the 1st and 2nd floor and a school in the basement.

During the investigation many noises and personal experiences were had. Including a ball moving on it's own after Investigator Tony asked for the children to get together and move the ball in the middle of the floor. But as all old, crumbling buildings go, many bats, raccoons, and other wild animals were amongst us during the investigation too. Even with the critters it was an amazing experience and worth the trip!



On the second night of the Expedition, PIM investigated Eastern State Penitentiary. This was a much anticipated investigation given it's haunted reputation and history. The building is very ornate and beautiful. PIM was given access to much of the prison, and set up a large amount of equipment throughout the location to try and capture evidence. However, since it was impossible to go anywhere without a tour guide escort (an unbreakable rule), and guides waiting in the rotunda talking amongst themselves during the investigation, made EVP sessions virtually worthless. The prison itself is also surrounded by downtown Philadelphia. Music, people talking, helicopters, cars, etc. could be heard inside the building. Not to mention that it was also a very windy night. So needless to say no evidence was collected during this investigation but it was amazing to visit the building itself and be a part of it's rich history. For any history buff it would be worth the day time tour, but PIM won't be paying for a private investigation in the future.

It was then time to pack up and make the trip back to Wisconsin and much cooler weather. It was a great trip and set the stage for the week long Expedition that PIM will be taking this month!!! PIM is definitely ready for the trip to Mansfield Penitentiary, Sedamsville Rectory, Bobby Mackie's Music World, and Waverly Hills Sanatorium!

Mel-8704REMSDDATDD

This customized designed Mel, uses the standard single-axis EMF meter and K-type thermocouple and adds a Shadow detector, Temperature change alarm, and an antenna that emits

a small EM field that sets off audible and visual alarms if disturbed. PIM has been using this unit for several months now, and the Shadow detector is by far the most intriguing. Two different investigations have yielded an alarm that can't be explained. PIM is still vetting this unit, so stayed tuned for an update!
