## Public Investigation at the Four Seasons Island Resort

On April 12th and 13th PIM will be returning to the historic Four Seasons Island Resort in Pembine, WI. The history of the resort began in 1905 on a beautiful Fall day as the lush Miscauno Inn. The unique charm of the Inn with it's massive fireplace, expensive chandeliers, silver plated wall sconces and breathtaking scenic views of the Menominee River drew guests from all around. But in 1923 it burned to the ground and all that remained was the massive fireplace.

In 1925 it reopened as the Four Seasons Club. It attracted many celebrities and distinguished guests as well as a retreat for Al Capone and questionable ties to the Chicago underground.

In recent years, and now under the name Four Seasons Resort, many of it's guests and employees have made claims of paranormal activities. Some of the claims are of apparitions of both male and female entities seen walking around the hotel, an employee was touched in the elevator, another employee heard their named called, a rocking chair in the enclosed front porch has been seen rocking by itself, guests have reported seeing shadows in their hotel rooms, the towel dispenser in the ladies room on the 1st floor have gone off simultaneously for no reason, and the water faucet in the men's room turned on by itself in the older part of the resort, among other claims.

PIM has had it's own "paranormal experience" on a recent trip to the resort. A voice of a female or small child was captured on audio in Lillie's Ice Cream Parlor after an investigator offered a dime for ice cream to anyone who wanted to take it. PIM is unsure what the voice is saying but is fairly convinced it is something paranormal in nature. ### Recent Investigation News/Highlights

- On February 8th investigators Noah, John and Missy investigated a private residence in Reeseville, WI. This was an interesting case involving many claims including apparitions, tapping sounds, disembodied voices, shadows, and many others. The investigators did experience a strange noise that they could not identify while at the location but upon evidence review it was determined the noise was not paranormal. However, further research will be needed on this case to determine what is going on.
- On February 15th PIM investigator John along with two new investigators Denys and Mary investigated the apartment of a family in Milwaukee, WI. This location was a little more difficult to investigate since there were sounds coming from the other tenants in the apartment complex. PIM is convinced that many of the claims on this case could be debunked and is most likely caused by sounds and vibrations coming from the other apartments. Since this was not a completely controlled environment it is hard to come to a complete conclusion on this investigation, but the client was satisfied with our explanations and felt better before the team left.
- On February 22nd PIM investigators Noah, Gravy, John, and Missy investigated the Times Cinema in Wauwatosa, WI. This was a great investigation of a historic location in the area.
