## Member Spotlight:


Each month we'll highlight a member's story. This month we feature investigator **Randy S.**

After graduating from college I engaged in several different hobbies from scuba diving (PADI licensed), watercolor painting, wood carving, electronics, coin detecting, photography, traveling around the world., and now paranormal investigating.

I joined PIM because watching all the ghost stories on TV and knowing people who claim to have experienced some kind of exposure to ghosts, interested me enough to want to determine why scientific research is minimal in this field. I'm a skeptic with a strong religious background and this is why I believe there has to be a 4th dimension, and contact-ing people in it should be possible.

Our world is a mysterious place, superstitions and legends abound. I've been with PIM now for 1 year and over this time have learned the right and wrong ways to investigate paranormal activities. The wrong way is to believe everything people tell you, the right way is to do your own research and use scientific methodology. Over half of the equipment I use, was built by me to help me understand exactly what we are looking for in a area determined to be haunted. I believe my place in the group is to help PIM determine if person's are of sound mind and health when they experience a ghostly encounter. ## Equipment Spotlight:



**GQ GMC-300 Geiger Counter:** This Geiger counter measures beta and gamma radiation. What is special

about it is that it has a built-in datalogger that will take a measurement every second. Once the investigation is concluded, the unit can be connected to a computer and the data downloaded and graphed over time to see if there are any changes during the investigation. Besides being useful to detect anomalies, this unit is also good for detecting Radon leaks in client's homes. This unit only cost \$150 shipped.

### MANSFIELD REFORMATORY

The next stop on our Expedition is Mansfield Reformatory. The reformatory was originally built to be an intermediate step between the Boys Industrial School and the Ohio Penitentiary. The reformatory has seen many dark days including in 1948 two former OSR inmates kidnapped and murdered the prison's farm superintendent, his wife and daughter leaving them in a cornfield. Two correction officers were murdered in 1926 when a paroled inmate returned to the prison and shot them outside the west gate. Another correction officer died after being beaten with an iron bar during an escape attempt by a dozen prisoners in 1932. Many prisoners also died under what is said to have been miserable conditions at Mansfield Reformatory. Rumors of the spirits of tortured inmates who died in the prison fill the halls with restless energy, unable to escape the prison's bars. Rumors of guilty guards also contribute to the stories of the haunted facility, as they remain trapped in the gruesome nightmare they created for the prisoners locked inside. It is curious to think about what PIM will find as they wander the cell blocks of Mansfield Reformatory.

### Recent Investigation News/Highlights

PIM would like to stress that our main purpose during any investigation is to help those who are experiencing things in their home or business! We always hope to find logical explanations for the phenomenon that they may be experiencing. Our first order of business is to try and debunk as much of the activity that we can.

On March 29th PIM had the opportunity to investigate a private residence in West Allis, WI. During our time at this home no evidence was recorded but it is always an honor for PIM to be invited into someone's private home and we would like to thank the owners for this wonderful opportunity.

On April 5th PIM investigated the Pabst Brewery Headquarters. PIM was joined by special guest Michael Brown, Executive Producer of the Haunted State Documentary. Although no evidence was collected during this investigation the location is both architecturally beautiful and rich in history. We are hoping to return another time to continue our research of this amazing location.

On April 6th PIM had another opportunity to investigate a private home in Waupun, WI. Most of the claims were able to be debunked but the investigation was a great opportunity for PIM.
